

PIP Quarters

- PIP Quarters are not the same as state fiscal year, federal fiscal year, or calendar year quarters.
- All steps in PIP Matrix Part A. must be accomplished in Quarter 1-8, as designated on the matrix, but may be in more than one quarter and may be “ongoing.”
- Any action steps completed after Statewide Assessment and before PIP begins will be labeled as Quarter 1 and evidence of completion will be submitted.

PIP Quarter 6	July 1, 2012 – Sept. 30, 2012	
PIP Quarter 7	Oct. 1, 2012 – Dec. 31, 2012	
PIP Quarter 8	Jan. 1, 2013 – March 31, 2013	
Year of “non-overlapping data”	April 1, 2013 – Mar. 31, 2014	Data will be measured for one additional year after conclusion of PIP, which means the level of improvements on national data standards of Placement Stability and Maltreatment in FC must meet the level of improvement by this time in order to avoid financial penalties.
